As part of its celebrations for Festival Week, Sale Festival 2021 is running a Photographic Competition for keen Amateur Photographers on the theme of

“Power and Energy”

Power and Energy are all around us all the time. Whether it's an athlete straining to go faster, or a weightlifter lifting a heavy weight, or the many other human related activities that make us sweat !! Mechanical machines that we take for granted in everyday life - such as locomotives, engines, cars and motorbikes all exude Power and Energy in their own way. But it doesn't have to be a manmade entity. Think of a forest fire or lightening strikes, or massive waves crashing onto a beach. All of these are representations of Power & Energy. The list is endless.

Photographers of all ages are invited to capture the essence of the theme by taking part in this Photographic Competition aimed at picturing the very best of Power and Energy.

Amateur Photographers who would like to enter the competition should **submit up to 4 digital images** to **compsec@salefestival.org.uk** to arrive no later than **Sunday 23rd May 2021**

An esteemed Judge will judge the competition during the week prior to Festival Week, and the winning images and a selection of the runners up will form part of a digital exhibition which can be accessed on-line.

The winner of the Senior Competition will receive a fabulous prize of £50, which will be presented to them during Festival Week, with runners up prizes of £25 for 2nd place and £10 for 3rd place.

There is also a Junior Section for Photographers up to 16 years of age, with the winner receiving a prize of £25.

Competition Rules (Also see salephoto.org.uk or salefestival.org.uk websites for the Rules)

1. The Competition Theme will be titled “Power and Energy”
2. There are no age restrictions on who can enter.
The Junior Section is for entrants aged 16 or under on June 1st 2021
Family and work colleagues of the Judge and the competition organisers will be ineligible to enter.
3. **Entrants must not be professional or semi-professional photographers**
4. All entries **must** be in digital form and can be in monochrome or colour with a maximum image size of 10MB. **Ideally, images should be 1600x1200 pixels.**
A maximum of 4 images per author may be entered
5. The Author's name, address, email address, phone numbers (and age if under 16 and entering the Junior Competition), must be sent with the entry, together with the image title and when and where it was taken
6. The closing date for entries in the competition is Sunday 23rd May 2021.
7. Entries for the competition should be sent to **compsec@salefestival.org.uk**
8. The Judge's decision is final and no correspondence on that decision will be entered into
9. The winning prints, runners up, and a selection of other images will be exhibited in an on line Exhibition of Visual Arts during Sale Festival Week and for the following 3 weeks.
10. All entries must be the original work of the author and must not have been previously published. The entrants must be the sole owner of the copyright in all photos and must have the permission of any people featured in the entries
11. By entering the competition, entrants grant the right for Sale Festival and Sale Photographic Society to publish their images on their respective websites or in any other media as they think fit
