This is our sixth annual Beer Festival. As always, we have made some changes based on previous festivals and we hope that they result in an even more enjoyable experience this year. We are pleased to be linked with the Sale Festival again this year and thank the organisers for their support.

Please enjoy the beers, the company and the facilities & surrounds of our club. If you are not a member and wish to join please talk to any existing member. Finally, in consideration of our neighbours, we ask that, when leaving the club you do so quietly especially if it is late in the evening.

### The beers we have and how to enjoy them

We have a select range of cask beers on offer and our 'menu', incorporating tasting notes, appears on the following pages. We have seventeen cask beers, some you may remember from previous years. Four are available from our main bar and the other thirteen are available from the temporary bar. All beers are served chilled and dispensed through hand pumps.

All the cask beers are priced at £3.00 a pint & £1.50 for a half and from whichever bar they are served they should be paid for by tokens which can be bought at the main bar. Cash will not be accepted at the temporary bar.

When you order any of the beers just present your token to the person serving and they will mark off the appropriate value(s) /volumes to signify what you have spent.

**So remember: Tokens can be bought from the main bar and can be redeemed at either bar for the cask beers only.**

### What else is on offer

In addition to our draft (cask & keg) beers we have a range of bottled beers, ciders, Prosecco and wines along with a selection of non alcoholic drinks. Also ham/cheese salad barm cakes, ploughman's & hot dogs will be available along with an assortment of crisps and other nibbles and free lollipops for the youngsters.





On Saturday, up to late afternoon, a members only bowling competition will be held on the green and in the evening there will be a darts knockout competition.

On Sunday the green is available all day for some 'fun' bowling so feel free to try your hand! At 1:00pm we will be televising England's World Cup Group Match against Panama and the BBQ will be available between 2:00 & 4:00pm There will also be live music with George and his guitar (and amp) from 3:00pm.

### CASK BEERS FROM OUR MAIN BAR

 Thwaites Original	Marstons	Bitter	3.6%
A beer that's as Original today as it was in 1807, when Daniel Thwaites himself began brewing. A clean dry tasting and refreshing session bitter with a glowing amber appearance. Brewed using premium grade Maris Otter malt and a blend of traditional English Hops including Goldings and Fuggles to give a malty flavoured beer with a delicate dry finish			
 Wainwright	Marstons	Golden Ale	4.1%
Exquisitely lovely golden ale. Named after Alfred Wainwright, the renowned Lakeland author who was born in Blackburn. Wainwright is a refreshing golden ale with subtle sweetness and delicate citrus fruity overtones			
 Bombardier	Charles Wells (Marstons)	Copper Ale	4.1%
Savour the distinct aroma, then surrender to the perfect balance of malty richness, tangy hops and sultana fruit on the palate. Natural mineral water, the ripest English fuggles hops and crushed crystal malt deliver this experience of England in a glass. Brace yourself for a long soft spicy finish.			
 Bollington, Cheshire	White Nancy	Pale bitter	3.6%
A pale coloured Best Bitter with lots of body & good fruity taste. Not overly sweet. We believe its consistent popularity since its introduction in 2015 deserves its elevation to 'main bar status' this year! White Nancy is a structure at the top of the northern extremity of The Saddle of Kerridge, overlooking the village of Kerridge and the town of Bollington. It is a designated Grade II listed building and its profile forms the logo for the town.

 Bootleg, Chorlton	Spin Doctor	Lager	4.8%
Premium indie lager. Clean taste, light straw colour with the glorious aromas of Ella and Summer Australian hops. Ella brings light, fruity, gently herbal notes which blend perfectly with the balanced melon and peach characteristics of Summer. A refreshingly different spin on lager. Now an established brew at the club since we brought it in at our last festival!

	PRODUCT	BREWERY	STYLE	STRENGTH
	Pre-Prohibition	Stubborn Mule, Altrincham	Cream Ale	5.5%
	This pilsner/pale ale hybrid is a refreshingly light & crisp beer. The recipe is a nod to the US pre-prohibition era so its Liberty hops to add a refreshing essence of citrus, grapes, peaches and vanilla. Crash cooled for a clean finish the perfectly timed drop of honey along with a double dose of hops makes this an interesting yet easy drinker for all.			
	Absolute Banker	Stubborn Mule, Altrincham	Pale Ale	4.7%
	A resinous, earthy intensity from the Magnum hops and some spiciness from the Liberty, allows the citrus characteristics of the legendary Cascade hops shine through. The clean, crisp profile of the US-05 yeast provides a great platform to showcase this beer.			
	Blueberry Bitter	Coach House Warrington	Strong Bitter	5.0%
	Pale straw in colour with a light delicate bitterness and the natural flavour of Blueberries, with a light hoppy aroma and a distinctly fruity aftertaste			
	Cheshire Gold	Coach House Warrington	Golden/Blond	4.1%
	Gold it's called and gold it is in body clear and good multi sized bubbles make a most respectable crowning pure white head. Rich on the nose filling the air like a seaside sweet shop with aromas of proper dairy fudge and butterscotch with notes of melon. Drinking in pretty much all senses with mid ranged mouthfeel and decent if inoffensive tastes.			
	Clipaty Hop	Coach House Warrington	IPA	4.3%
	An English style IPA, light in colour with a hoppy aroma and flavour but with a well balanced malty finish.			
	Blond Rogue	Beer Monkey	Blond Ale	3.8%
	Now this is a real Rebel leader!! A real blonde brew packed with citrus flavours & aroma. You will find it hard to resist the light thirst quenching taste of this serious Skipton Ale!!

	A juicy, bright, dry pale. Hopped extensively with Centennial, Citra and Mosaic hops at flame out & dry hop. Designed to be a taste of sunshine with late citrus fruit aroma and finish.			
	Citrus Snap	Green Mill Brewery	Golden/Blond Ale	3.8%
	Pale bitter hopped with Citra hops Green Mill brewery is situated in The Harewood Arms, Broadbottom, Hyde.			
	Chirotherium	Lymm Brewing Co.	Dark Ale	5.5%
	A Smooth Dark Old English Ale named after the dinosaur whose footprints are impressed in mudstone near Lymm Dam. Chirotherium means Hand Animal. It is the only dinosaur capable of holding a pint of beer having four fingers and a thumb on each of its front limbs			
	Peach Ale	Seven Bro7hers	Pale	4.0%
	An English style session pale ale with a peach aroma. The brewery is in Salford Quays and there is a Beerhouse in Ancoats. Seven Bro7hers is run by ..... 7 brothers!!			
	Costa Del Salford	Irwell Works Brewery	Light Ale	4.1%
	Brewed as a summer ale this beer is light in colour with bags of flavour. <b>** GLUTON FREE **</b> The brewery is situated in the former Irwell Steam, Tin, Copper and Iron Works in Ramsbottom.			
	Marshmallow Unicorn	Irwell Works Brewery	Stout	4.4%
	A stout containing lactose, a sugar derived from milk. Being unfermentable it adds sweetness, body, and calories to the finished beer.
